



HARTWELL THROUGH THE AGES

Alice Hartwell in California recently emailed me the obituary for Walter Hartwell Morse II, wondering if he could be related to her. After a bit of searching in census records, I found this progression back to his Hartwell ancestry.

Walter <u>Hartwell</u> Morse II (1929-2012) married Sally Atwood

Stewart Morse (1900-1995) (had a brother named <u>Hartwell</u> Morse) married Elsa ()

Walter <u>Hartwell</u> Morse (1870-??) married Louise (__) <u>Hartwell</u> Morse (1843-??) married Kate Johnson (1845-??)

Ellis Morse (1789-1869) married Adaline Bagg (1808-1874)

Dr. Henry Bagg (d. 1824) married Sukey <u>Hartwell</u> (1789-1824)

Isaac Hartwell (1752-1831) married Eunice Mirick (1759-1823)

Ephraim Hartwell (1706-1793) married Elizabeth Heywood (1714-1808)

Samuel Hartwell (1666-1744) married Abigail Stearns (1671-1709)

Samuel Hartwell (1645-1725) married Ruth Wheeler (ca. 1647-1713)

William Hartwell (ca. 1613-1689/90) married Jezan (__) (ca. 1608-1695)

I found it amazing that the Morse family has retained the Hartwell name in some form through six generations!

A NAME CHANGE MYSTERY

My attempts to connect Frank William Hartwell of Salt Lake City, Utah to a Hartwell family descended from William¹ of Concord, who also lived in the Salt Lake City area, revealed a strange circumstance. Frank William's obituary stated that he was born at Salt Lake City 20 January 1928 to Leroy David and Sarah Florence (Jones) Hartwell. Since Frank's father's name was almost identical to that of David Leroy9 Hartwell (Byron Elliot8, Elliot6, Stephen6, Solomon5, Daniel4, William3, Samuel2, William¹) of Utah, I thought there might be a connection.

I tried tracking the family through census records.

The 1930 census contained this family in SLC:

Leroy D. Hartwell, head of household, age 41 Sarah F. Hartwell, wife, age 42 Sarah D. Hartwell, daughter, age 18 Virginia A. Hartwell, daughter, age 14 Donna C. Hartwell, daughter, age 11 Pearl J. Hartwell, daughter, age 8 Frank W. Hartwell, son, age 2 Sarah E. McDonnell, mother, age 63 Florence E. McDonnell, sister, age 23

Going back to 1920, this census record was found, also in SLC:

Leroy D. Hartwell, head of household, age 31 Sarah F. Hartwell, wife, age 32 Sarah I. Hartwell, daughter, age 8 Virginia A. Hartwell, daughter, age 3y 11m. Donna C. Hartwell, daughter, age 11m. Sarah McDonnell, mother, age 52 Florence E. McDonnell, sister, age 13

The only possible Hartwell match in 1910 was David Leroy Hartwell, but he was age 35, with a wife named Caroline, so it couldn't be him. I decided to try to find Sarah McDonnell in 1910, to see if her household would hold any clues and came up with:

Archibald J. McDonnell, head of household, age 43 Sarah C. McDonnell, wife, age 42 Leroy D. McDonnell, son, age 22 Sarah F. McDonnell, wife, age 22 Florence E. McDonnell, daughter, age 3

It would appear that sometime between 1910 and 1920, Archibald McDonnell died, leaving a widow (Sarah C.), a son (Leroy D.) with a wife (Sarah F.), and a daughter (Florence E.). Why Leroy changed his name, and that of his family, from McDonnell to Hartwell, while continuing to live with his

McDonnell mother and sister, is a puzzle, as is any possible connection to the David Leroy Hartwell family.

OUERIES

Amanda Hooper is looking for the ancestors of her 3rd great grandfather, William W. Hartwell. William was born probably in New York ca. 1813 and died apparently sometime between 1880 when he is listed on the census in New London, Huron County, Ohio, and 1885 when his second wife is called a widow. William married twice – first in either 1843 or 1844 (records vary) to Philena Frink, who died 30 May 1865. William W. then married 2 Dec. 1865, Fanny Vance, who after being widowed, moved to Nebraska with the younger children. Neither Amanda nor myself have had any luck finding who William's parents may have been.

Peter Cooper is looking for information about Emily Locklin, daughter of Miranda Hartwell. Emily married Samuel Cooper ca. 1861, and Peter is trying to find the exact location of the marriage, as the only reference he has found so far is in the 1956 Hartwell genealogy, which he thinks is based on Miranda's recollection of events. He would also like any details of Emily's life prior to her marriage, info on how she met her husband (Samuel Cooper was from England), and especially any correspondence she had with her family between 1861 and 1891.

Minutes of the 2011 Annual Business Meeting of the Hartwells of America

On Saturday, June 25, 2011, twenty-seven Hartwell cousins and friends assembled at the Trinitarian Congregational Church, Concord, MA, for the Hartwells of America Association's Seventy-Fourth Annual Reunion. As usual, the weather cooperated magnificently.

President Wayne E. Hartwell (Foxborough, MA) called the business meeting to order at 12:40 p.m.

Roger Whitcher Hartwell (Quincy, MA) offered an opening prayer, followed by a moment of silence to remember Hartwell cousins departed since the last Reunion.

Because our long-time hostess, Marian Wheeler (Concord, MA) and others had to leave early for other commitments, the usual order of things was rearranged with the group photograph being taken as the first item of business. Wayne announced that due to the retirement of Association Photographer, Alison Hartwell, the Executive Committee had appointed Katy Hartwell (Foxborough, MA) to the position.* At the same time, Wayne noted that the position of Corresponding Secretary, which Alison had held for many years, would go unfilled since—between Joy's and David's handling of the genealogical and financial correspondence, respectively, and Wayne's and Recording Secretary Judy Hartwell's assumption of the task of mailing the Newsletter—there was nothing for a Corresponding Secretary to do.

Reunion newcomers Helen Maher (Estes Park, CO), along with daughter Krista Erikson and grandsons Josh, David, Erik, and Daniel Erikson (Reading, MA) were welcomed aboard. The minutes of the 2010 business meeting, as published in the 2011 Newsletter, were accepted.

David Hartwell Webber (Dunstable, MA) delivered the Treasurer's report. The balance on hand in the Scholarship Fund at the close of the Association's 2011 Fiscal Year totaled a very respectable \$17,054.47, including donations received during the Fiscal Year in the sum of \$1,050.00. The Operating Fund, which pays for the Reunion, Newsletter, and other Association operating expenses, stood at \$2,198.83. Operating Fund revenue for the year, from bank interest, dues, and the sale of Hartwell literature, totaled \$911.11, and the expenses for the year for Scholarships (three at \$150.00), Newsletter, postage, the Reunion, and a \$25 donation to the Friends of Minuteman National Park totaled \$1.281.75.

In the absence of Scholarship Committee Chairperson Victoria H.C. Rogers (Otisfield, ME), David also reported that no applications for grants from the Scholarship Fund had been received for the 2011-2012 academic year.

In recognition of David's forty years' service as Association Treasurer, Wayne presented him with a framed Hartwell Tavern print.

^{*} Your Editor cannot resist mentioning that last month Katy, a former Hartwell Scholarship recipient, graduated from Bridgewater State University with a BA in Art, majoring in photography, *magna cum laude*.

Genealogist Joy F. Peach (Lancaster, MA) reported on her ongoing research for "missing" Hartwells and thanked Wayne for researching the article (2011 Newsletter, p. 6) discrediting the "Hartwell Family News," so-called, an issue of which she brought along for attendees to examine for themselves.

Before Marian Wheeler left for her other commitment, Wayne presented her with a framed Hartwell Tavern print in thanks for her fifteen years of hosting the Association's Reunions, a responsibility (at 94), she relinquished "to simplify things."

Contributions were voted to Trinitarian for the use of its facilities (\$200) and attendance of its Sexton (\$75), and to the Social Law Library for the efforts of the Library's graphic designer in preparing the Association's Newsletter (\$50).

Turning to the annual awards, Lucy Booth, of Framingham, MA, was the eldest lady (90) in atten-dance. The eldest gentleman in attendance was Roger Whitcher Hartwell (71), who nosed out David Webber by a single year. The youngest attendee was newbie Daniel Erikson. For traveling the farthest to attend, Daniel's grandmother, Helen Maher (Estes Park, CO) had no competition. Hartwell Tavern T-Shirts and tote bags were distributed to the winners.

Door Prize winners were Tina Seeger (Pepperell, MA), who walked away with a Hartwell Tavern Tote Bag, and the lucky Daniel Erikson, who also garnered a factory reject "Hartwell Gas Company" polo shirt from the Hartwell Apparel Company, Hartwell, GA. (unfortunately, there's no family connection, the company's named for the city).**

Lastly, it was voted to hold the 2012 Reunion at Trinitarian, which has proven to be very accommodating.***
